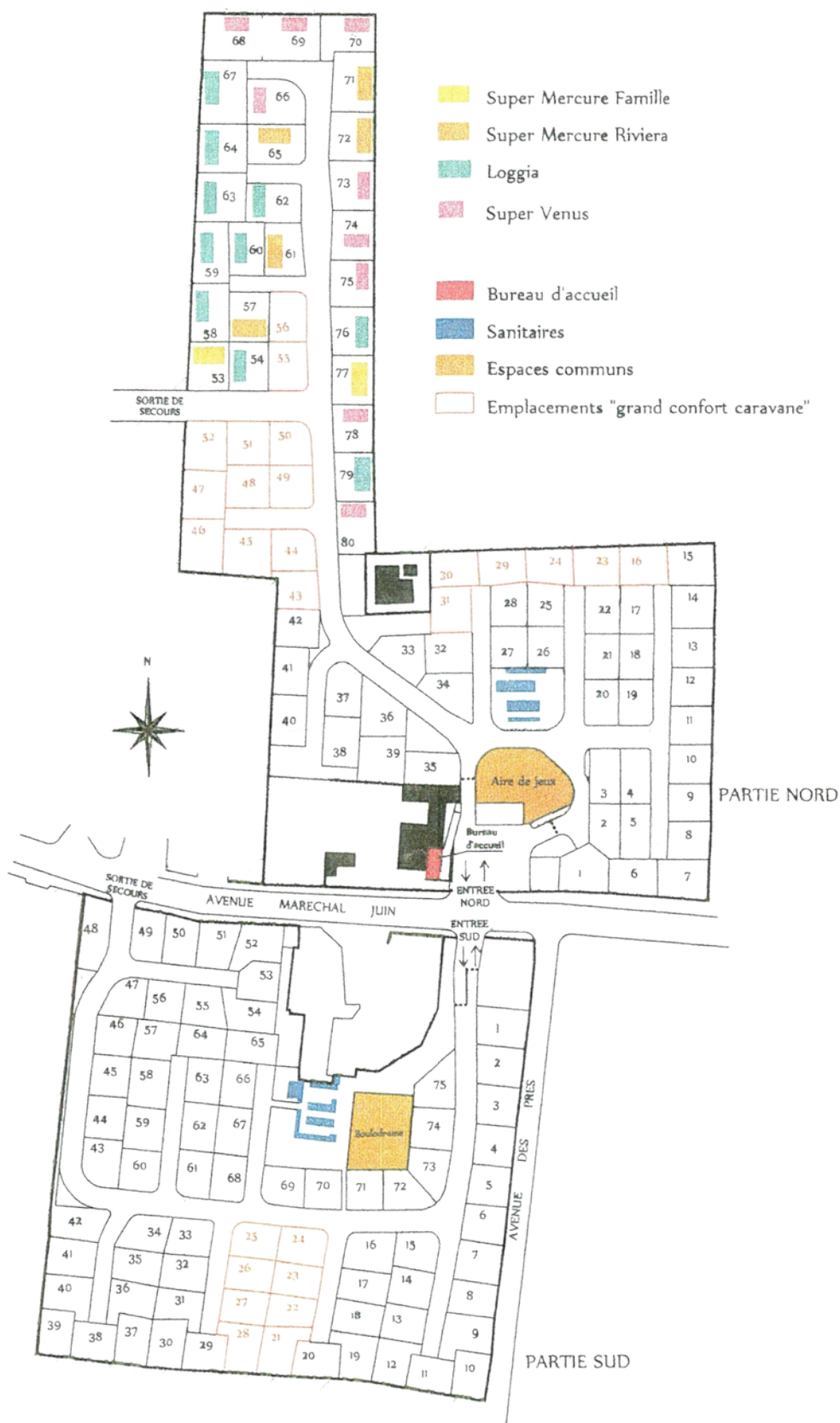

FIRE SAFETY

As you may already know, our region's dry Mediterranean climate makes it particularly vulnerable to fires.
Please read these instructions very carefully.

Fire Prevention

- It is forbidden to throw away your cigarette butts, and to be careful on the windy days.
- Beware of inflammable products.
- Do not light open fires.
- Wood, coal BARBECUES are strictly prohibited, also candle or petrol lamps...

How to help the emergency services

- Note the location of the nearest fire hydrants and extinguishers.
- Check the emergency exit routes.
- Always leave emergency exits clear and do not hinder emergency service access.
- Park your car always facing an exit, totally inside your plot (minimum 50 cm from the plot edges).

In case of fire

- **Do not panic.**
- Cut off gas and electricity meters in your camper van, caravan or tent.
- Try to put out the fire using the nearest fire-fighting means.
- Call the management and fire brigade
- Direct your family towards the campsite meeting point (look for it on the map)
Follow the instructions issued by the management.
- In case of a fire alarm, leave the danger zone immediately.

**Always stay calm and clear-headed. Fire spreads quickly;
leave the campsite immediately and calmly on foot.**

FLOODING – COASTAL STORMS

**All campers will be informed to evacuate by the management of the camping site.
In these circumstances, keep calm and scrupulously follow these instructions:**

1. Close outside gas supplies and cut off the electricity of camper van, caravan or tent.
2. Make for higher ground or muster points as quickly as possible
3. Only take your identity papers, money and valuable objects with you
4. Leave your vehicle and your camping equipment
5. Do not take refuge in caravans (in the case of severe flooding or coastal storms, they can be carried away)
6. Do not return until instructed to do so

**Consult the evacuation plan for the camping site at reception.
Note your escape route to the muster point in advance.
Evacuation routes are indicated by the arrows (blue, green).**
